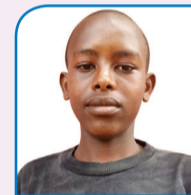

PUBLIC NOTICE ON THE PREPARATION OF 2021/22- 2023/24 MEDIUM TERM EXPENDITURE FRAMEWORK (MTEF) BUDGET

The County Government of Kajiado (CGK) is in the process of preparing the 2021/22FY Budget in accordance to the requirements of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012. The Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides for public participation in policy formulation. Further, the PFM Act, 2012 Section 125 (2) requires the County Executive Committee member for finance to ensure that there is public participation in the budget process.

The MTEF budget will be anchored on 2021 County Fiscal Strategy Paper (CFSP) with the main focus areas as: To achieve sustainable food security, improved nutrition and value addition; Ensure healthy lives and promote the well-being of citizens; Investment in social welfare to improve livelihoods and; To promote productive employment and entrepreneurship.

Going forward, the CGK informs all the public of this process. Additionally, the public is invited to draw memoranda on priority projects focusing on completion and operationalization of ongoing/stalled projects; possible sources of funding; investment strategies and cost saving measures. When doing this, the public is advised to make reference to the 2018-2022 County Integrated Development Plan, the 2021 Annual Development Plan and the 2021 CFSP available on the county's website.
